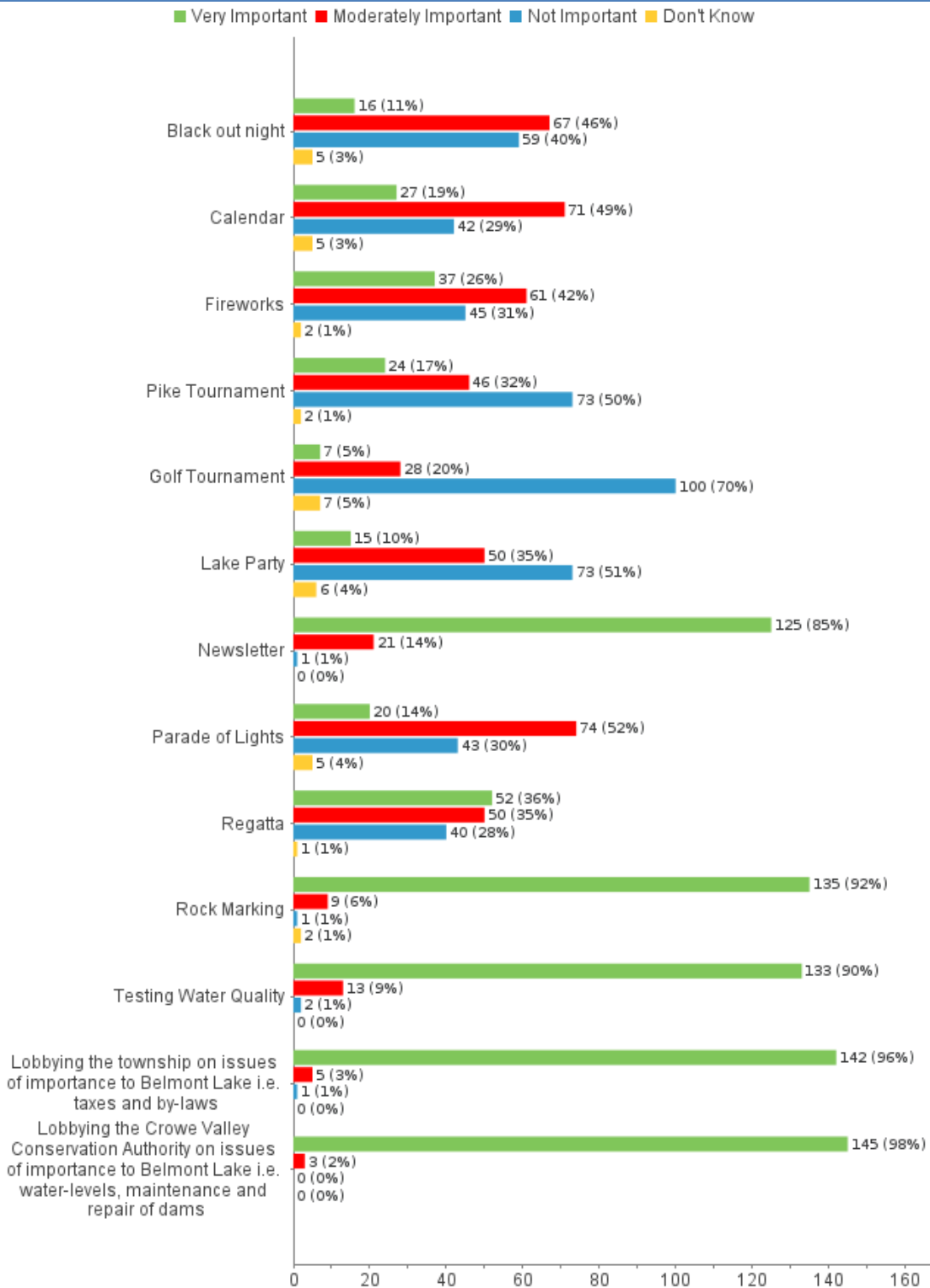

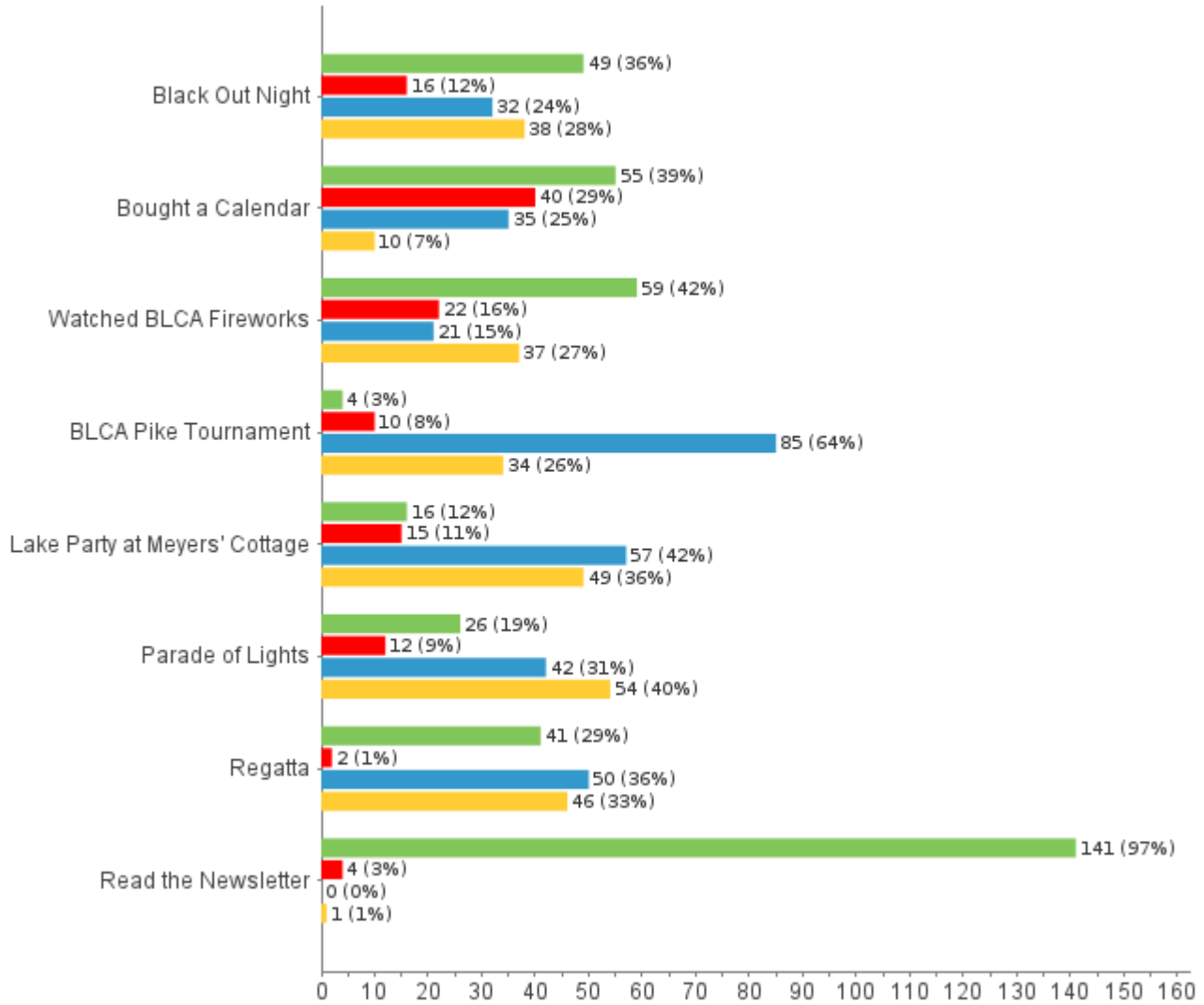

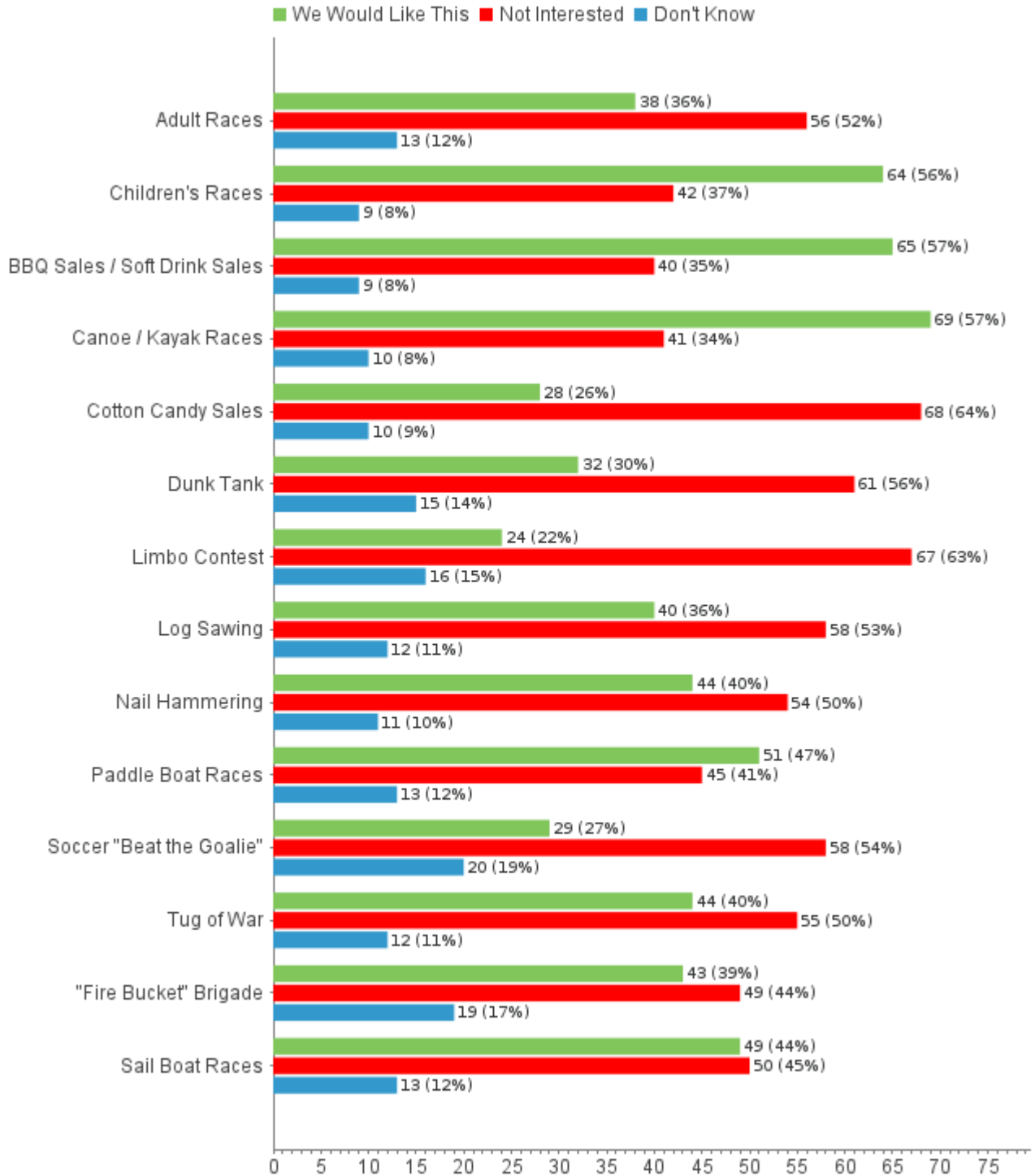
Overall, how would you rate the value for money of the \$30 BLCA Registration fee?

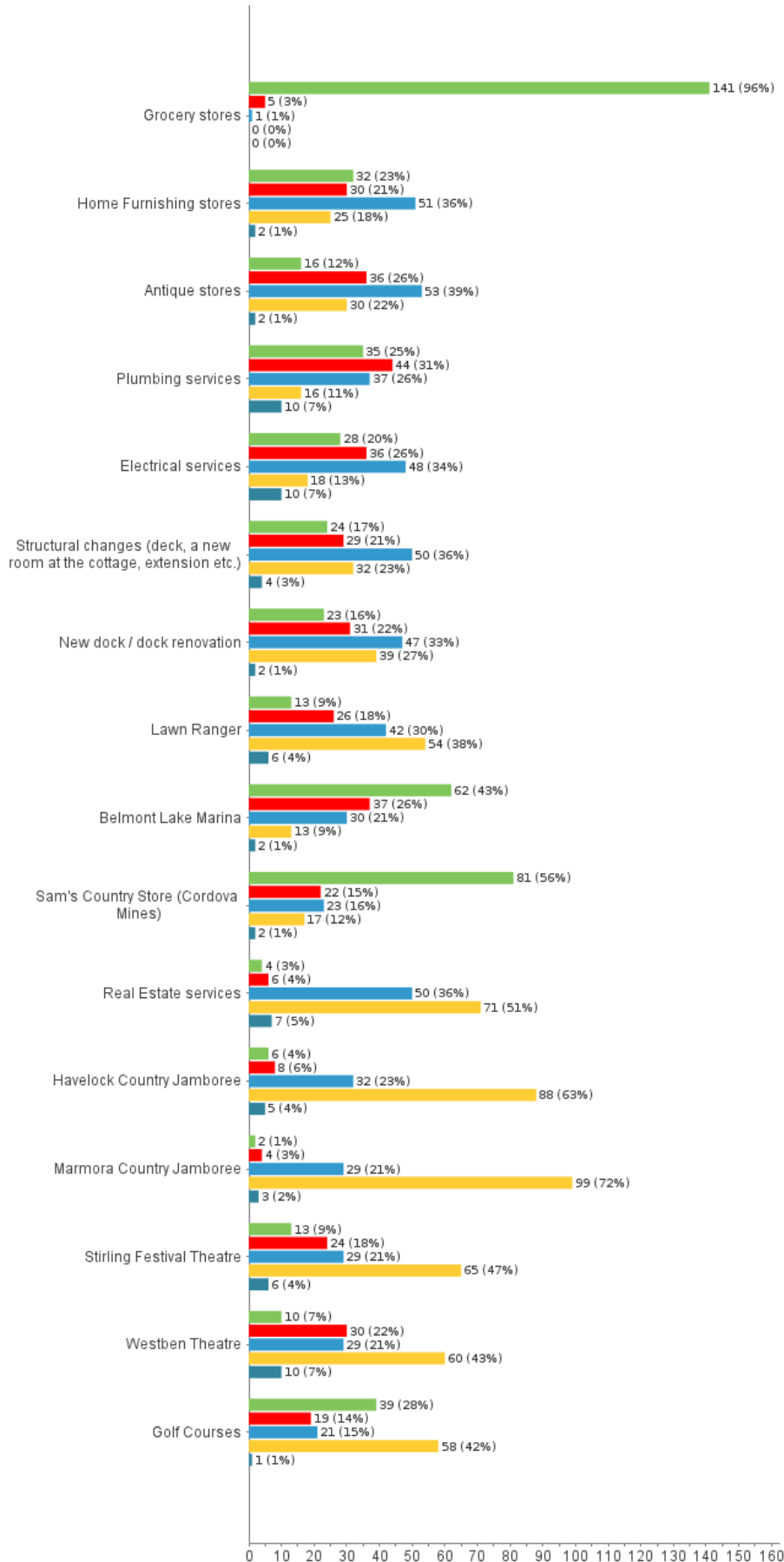

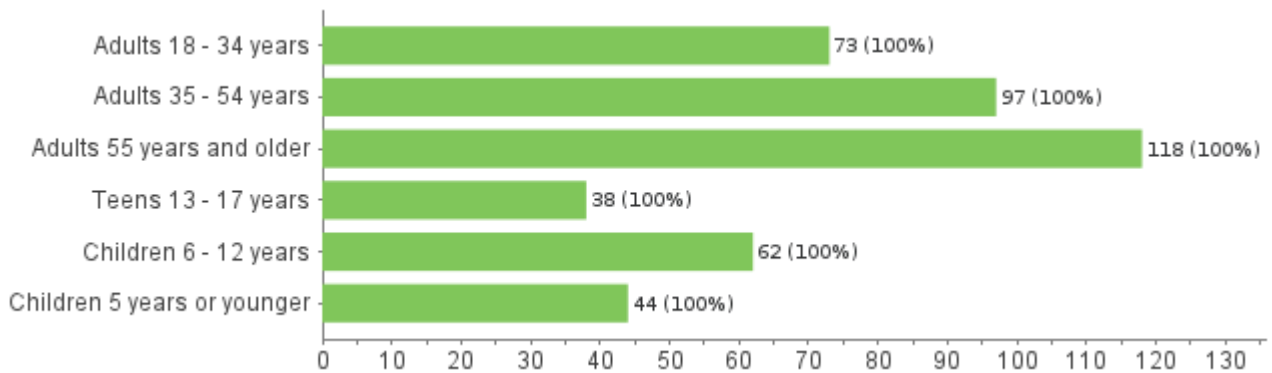
