- 2. Selection of Executive: Ed will continue as treasurer for this year. Art will be president for this year. Jim will be vice president.

- 3. Regatta: Craig and Trish Ferrier will be responsible for the swimming and boating events. Wayne Alexander and Gary McCarthy will look after hot dog sales. Mary Ellen will get St John?s Ambulance and OPP and boat safety trailer to come to the regatta. The regatta is on Sun. Aug. 5, from noon to 3:00 p.m. Jane Alexander will sell tickets for hot dog sales and 50-50 tickets. Greg will look after the water balloons and coloured eggs.
